- Exhibition dates:** January 12–February 7, 2010
- Reception date:** Thursday, January 14, 6:00-8:00pm
- Juror:** Nina Nielsen
For 46 years, Nina owned Nielsen Gallery on Newbury Street. Considered one of America's top gallerist, many of the artists she has represented over the years have works in major collections and museums.
- Prizes:** A total of \$1000 will be awarded, including the Jean Koch prize.
- Eligibility:** Concord Art Association members may submit up to two pieces. Artists may become members at time of delivery.
- Specifications:** Size of work can not exceed 48" in any direction. Two-dimensional work must be wired for hanging; no sawtooth hangers, no clip or sandwich frames. Framed work over 26" must be under plexiglass, not glass.
- Fees:** \$10 entry fee per piece. Two pieces allowed per member. Fees are non-refundable. All work must be for sale. The Concord Art Association receives one-third of the sale price.
- Delivery of work:** Wednesday, January 6, 10:00–7:00pm and Thursday, January 7, 10:00–4:00pm
- Pickup of unaccepted work:** Tuesday, January 12, 10:00am–4:30pm and Wednesday, January 13, 10:00am–7:00pm
- Pickup of accepted work:** Sunday, February 7, 3:00-4:00pm and Monday, February 8, 10-4:30pm
- Insurance:** The Concord Art Association carries a blanket policy covering fire, theft and breakage at 100% of the sale price. CAA insurance covers the work of an artist during the course of the exhibition only. CAA will not assume responsibility for work left after the designated pick up dates.
Artists will be charged a \$15 storage fee for any work not picked up by the designated dates.
