ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists, members and non-members alike, and any media is accepted. Work must have been completed within the last three years and not previously shown at the Concord Art Association.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

MEMBER artists may submit up to TWO pieces at \$15 per entry.

NON-MEMBERS may submit one piece at \$25.

Fees are non-refundable. Artists may become members at the time of delivery. All work must be for sale. The Concord Art Association receives 1/3 of the sale price. CAA reserves the right to photograph work for publicity purposes. Artists must complete the entry forms on the back of this flyer and attach to each piece of art.

SPECIFICATIONS

Maximum size 48" in any direction. Three-dimensional work must be stable with appropriate display units. Two-dimensional work must be suitably framed and firmly wired. Framed work larger than 26" must be under plexiglas, not glass. No sawtooth hangers, no sandwich/clip frames. Work not adhering to these specifications will not be accepted.

You will be notified of the jury selection via our website on October 30.

RETRIEVAL DATES

Work that is **not accepted** must be picked up by November 2 (during regular gallery hours).

Accepted work should be picked up November 29 (3-5pm) or November 30 (12noon-4pm).

ARTISTS WILL BE CHARGED A \$15 STORAGE FEE FOR ANY WORK NOT PICKED UP BY THE DESIGNATED DATES.

INSURANCE

The Concord Art Association carries a blanket policy covering fire, theft and breakage at 100% of the sale price. CAA insurance covers the work of an artist during the course of the exhibition only. CAA will not assume responsibility for work left after the designated pick up dates.
