JURIED BY JENNIFER GROSS

Jennifer Gross is the Chief Curator and Deputy Director of Curatorial Affairs at the deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum in Lincoln, Massachusetts. She was previously the Curator of Modern and Contemporary Art at the Yale University Art Gallery. Recent curatorial projects include Ian Hamilton Finlay: Arcadian Revolutionary and Avant-Gardener, and Richard Artschwager! She has written extensively on contemporary art including the work of Richard Tuttle, Kristin Baker, Josiah McElheny, Thomas Nozkowski, Jim Nutt and Rachel Whiteread. Gross received her PhD in Art History from the Graduate Center, City University of New York. She is currently organizing Drawing Redefined opening at deCordova on October 2nd, which will include the work of Roni Horn, Esther Klas, Jöelle Tuerlinckx, Richard Tuttle and Jorinde Voight.

PRIZES Totaling \$3,000 will be awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists, members and non-members alike, and all media accepted (2D, 3D and video). Work must have been completed within the last three years and not previously shown at Concord Art Association.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

MEMBER artists may submit up to two pieces at \$15 per entry.

NON-MEMBERS may submit one piece at \$25.

Fees are non-refundable. Artists may become members at the time of delivery. All work must be for sale. Concord Art receives 1/3 of the sale price and reserves the right to photograph work for publicity purposes. Artists must complete the entry forms that are in this flyer and attach to each piece of art.

SPECIFICATIONS

No artwork (all mediums) can exceed 60" in any direction (including frame/display units). 3D work must be stable. 2D wall mounted work must be firmly wired for hanging. Accepted video work must provide a viewing monitor and video in a continuous loop. Please, no saw tooth hangers, no sandwich/clip frames. We cannot accept work not adhering to these specifications.

NOTIFICATION

Accepted artists will be posted at **concordart.org** Friday, September 11, after 5pm.

RETRIEVAL DATES

Work that is not accepted must be picked up Saturday or Sunday, September 12 (10am-4:30pm) or September 13 (noon-4pm).

After the show closes, accepted work should be picked up Thursday, Friday or Saturday, October 22 (10am-4:30pm), October 23 (10am-4:30pm) or October 24 (10am-4pm). Artists will be charged a \$15 storage fee for work not picked up by the designated dates.

INSURANCE

Concord Art Association carries a blanket policy covering fire, theft and breakage at 100% of the sale price. Concord Art insurance covers the work of an artist during the course of the exhibition only. Concord Art will not assume responsibility for work left after the designated pick up dates.
